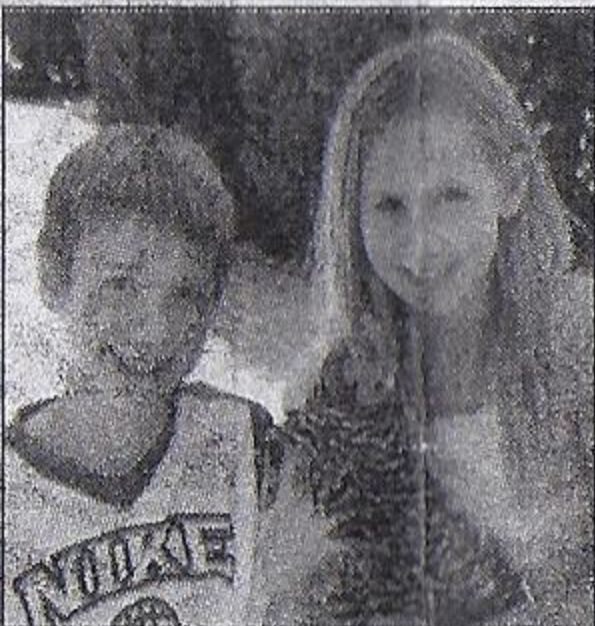


Youngsters keep busy with pet projects
